The practicum session is held during the month of **June**. Orientation is held a week before the practicum session begins. Please be aware that students will be shadowing a Certified Child Life Specialist following a full-time work schedule. Along with observation hours, students will be expected to complete assignments equivalent to the workload of one class.
